REPORT :

The Committee on Indian Affairs, to which was referred the petition of John Brown and James Brown, report :

That the petitioners claim compensation for their improvements abandoned under the Cherokee treaty of 1819. It appears that the petitioners took reservations under that treaty, and are therefore not entitled to relief.
