In compliance with a resolution of the Senate, a statement showing the annual receipts and expenditures of the Government since the year 1817.

FEBRUARY 11, 1839.

TREASURY DEPARTMENT, February 9, 1839.

SIR: I have the honor to present the accompanying statement, prepared by the Register of the Treasury, which has been made up to the 30th of September last, being as far as it can at present be ascertained, in obedience to the following resolution of the Senate of the 1st instant, to wit:

"Resolved, That the Secretary of the Treasury be, and he is hereby, directed to report to the Senate the total amount of revenue from all sources, which accrued, and was received into the public Treasury, and the aggregate amount of the expenditures of the General Government, in all branches of the public service, during each year, from the 1st day of January, 1817, to the 1st day of January, 1839, distinguishing the payments made in each year on account of the national debt, and showing for what objects the principal expenditures were made."

The other portion of the resolution has been previously answered.
