REPORT:

That this claim is for damages resulting from the destruction of dwelling and out-houses, and household and kitchen furniture, by hostile Indians, in 1840.

The committee have reported against several similar claims during the present session, and recommend the adoption of the following resolution:

Resolved, That the petitioner is not entitled to relief.
