REPORT :

The Committee on Indian Affairs, to whom were referred the claims of Roby & Utley, and of Charles C. Roby, against the Ottawa Indians, report :

The papers referred are, an account of Roby & Utley, amounting to \$394, and one of Charles C. Roby, amounting to \$230 02, against the Ottawa Indians, and affidavits attesting their correctness. There is no pretence or shadow of proof, however, that the United States are in any way responsible for the payment of these accounts. The committee, therefore, ask to be discharged from the further consideration of them.
