Mr. SEAMAN, from the Committee on Revolutionary Pensions, made the following

REPORT :

The Committee on Revolutionary Pensions, to whom was referred the petition of Lawrence Van Dyck and others, heirs of Jehoachim Van Valkenburg, report :

That the petitioners represent themselves to be the heirs of the said Van Valkenburg, and that he was shot by the Indians during the war of the Revolution. It does not appear that, at the time of his death, or at any time previous, he was in the service of the United States. The committee report the following resolution :

Resolved, That the prayer of the petitioners ought not to be granted.
