Mr. THOMPSON, from the Committee on Indian Affairs, made the following

REPORT :

The Committee on Indian Affairs, to whom was referred Senate bill No. 83, for the relief of Samuel W. Bell, a native of the Cherokee nation, have considered the same, and beg leave to report :

That it appears from the papers that the claim of Mr. Bell was rejected by the Commissioner of Indian Affairs, because at the time of its consideration the statute of limitation barred its allowance. This act, since that time, has been repealed, and therefore there is no necessity for the passage of this bill.
