Mr. SIDNEY LAWRENCE, from the Committee on Revolutionary Pensions, made the following

REPORT:

The Committee on Revolutionary Pensions, to whom was referred the memorial of Drusilla Bukey, report:

That the petitioner represents herself to be the widow of Hezekiah Bukey, a soldier in the Indian wars, after the close of the revolution.

The committee are considering the subject of extending the pension laws of the United States, so as to include this class of soldiers. They are not disposed to recommend their extension, unless by a general law.

The committee ask to be discharged from the further consideration of the memorial.
