The annual statement of the Register of the Treasury, showing the amounts credited to, and expenditures made on account of, the Chickasaw tribe of Indians, under the acts of October, 1832, and May, 1834.

Referred to the Committee of Ways and Means, and ordered to be printed.

TREASURY DEPARTMENT, March 4, 1850.

SIR: In compliance with the third section of the act entitled "An act to carry into effect the treaties concluded by the Chickasaw tribe of Indians on the 20th October, 1832, and 24th May, 1834," which provides that "a special account of the funds, under the said treaty, shall be kept at the treasury, and a statement thereof shall be annually laid before Congress," I have the honor to transmit, herewith, detailed statements from the Register of the Treasury, numbered 1, 2, and 3, showing the amounts credited to, and the expenditures made on account of, the respective trusts during the past year.

By the report of my predecessor, dated March 3, 1849, (Ex. Doc. No. 66, House of Representatives, thirtieth Congress, second session,) the balance to the credit of the general fund was - - - \$36, 143 49

Exhibits numbered 2 and 3 show the transactions in the trusts created by the fourth and eighth articles of the treaty of 1st July, 1834, for the year 1849; the former showing a balance of \$979 36, and the latter a balance of \$3,103 56, to the credit of the respective trusts.

The sales of land under the treaty stipulations during the year 1849, amount to the sum of \$6,161 40; statements marked A and B show, in detail, the sales for each month and the amount of incidental expenses for each quarter.

The receiver at Pontotoc reported the sum of \$2,689 88 to be in his hands on the 31st December last.

The investments made by this department in State stocks remain as reported by my predecessor in the document herein before referred to. All which is respectfully submitted.
