REPORT:

[To accompany joint resolution S. No. 42.]

The Committee on Military Affairs, to whom was referred the joint resolution to amend the act of September 28, 1850, for the payment of a company of Indian volunteers, so as to allow the members of said company bounty land and three months' extra pay, report:

That it is not, in the opinion of the committee, advisable so to extend the provisions of said act, and they ask to be discharged from the further consideration of the subject.
