Mr. Scorr, from the Committee on Indian Affairs, made the following

#### REPORT.

The Committee on Indian Affairs, to whom was referred the petition of Recile Compare, petitioning for permission to sell her Kansas half-breed lands, report:

1. That the petition does not set forth sufficiently to the satisfaction of the committee the rights of the parties to sell said Kansas halfneed lands, and that the case, as made out and set forth by the payer of the petitioner, would not warrant and justify the committee in anting said prayer.

The committee are unwilling to establish a precedent on such light ividence and testimony as has been adduced in the above case, to the right of Indians of disposing of and selling any lands which my have been reserved by government for their benefit.
