RESOLUTIONS

OF

THE LEGISLATURE OF ARIZONA

Requesting Arms.

JANUARY 25, 1865.--Referred to the Committee on Military Affairs and ordered to be printed.

RESOLUTIONS of instructions to the honorable Charles D. Poston.

Be it resolved by the legislative assembly of the Territory of Arizona, 1st. That the honorable Charles D. Poston, our delegate to the Congress of the United States, be instructed and requested to use every effort in his power to procure from the general government five hundred stand of Springfield rifled muskets, calibre fifty-eight, of the latest improved quality, with their equipments and fixed ammunition, sufficient for the purpose of arming and equipping a battalion of Arizona rangers for active service against the Apaches, and other hostile Indian tribes in this Territory.
