SIR: I have the honor to acknowledge the reference here from your department of the Senate resolution of the 21st ultimo, calling for a report of "the names of Indian superintendents and agents, and whether any, and if so which, of said superintendents and agents are absent from their posts," and herewith transmit a list of such officers in the service of the Indian department. The only officers absent from their posts at the date of the resolution, so far as is known to this office, are the following: Superintendent H. B. Denman and Special Agent J. W.
