REPORT:

[To accompany bill H. R. 4194.]

The Committee on Claims, to whom was referred the bill (H. R. 4194) for the relief of Dr. Walter Reed, submit the following report:

The claimant, Dr. Walter Reed, claims, for services rendered while a surgeon in the United States Army and receiving pay as such, to receive the pay allowed by law for discharging the duties of physician to the White Mountain Apache Indians on the San Carlos Reservation, Arizona. This claim comes under the provisions of section 1765, Revised Statutes. Your committee believe it will be unwise to depart from the policy set forth in that section, and therefore recommend that the bill do not pass.
