R E P O R T :

[To accompany bill H. R. 3155.]

The Committee on Indian Affairs, having had under consideration House bill No. 3155, beg leave to submit the following report:

Your committee are of the opinion that the action of the Hon. Commissioner of Indian Affairs, in endeavoring to save from waste the decaying fallen timber on the reservation in question, should be sustained by Congress, and that the bill under consideration should be passed, and the acts of the Hon. Commissioner of Indian Affairs in this connection ratified and confirmed.
