[To accompany H. Res. 137.]

*The Committee on Printing, to whom was referred the joint resolution (H. Res. 137) authorizing the printing of 15,000 additional copies of the Annual Report of the Director of the Bureau of Ethnology, submit the following report:*

The committee find upon investigation that the number provided in said resolution is the number printed annually since the organization of the Bureau. These annual reports embrace the aggregate results in a popular form of the progress and researches of the Bureau, and are designed for general distribution to schools, libraries, and collaborators of the Bureau.

The cost of illustrations for these reports has been materially reduced by the method of photolithographing. The estimated cost of printing the 15,000 additional copies is \$24,138.60.

The committee recommend the passage of the resolution.
