Mr. MILLER, of California, submitted the following

RESOLUTION:

*Resolved*, That the provisions of the resolution of the Senate adopted June 11, 1884, instructing the Committee on Indian Affairs to inquire into the condition of the several tribes and bands of Indians in the Indian Territory, &c., be extended to and embrace therein the Indians upon the several reservations in California, and that the said inquiry be directed particularly to the Round Valley Indian Reservation in said State; and that full investigation be made into the present and past management of said reservation, and of all abuses of the rights and interests of the Indians thereon.
