A statement of open-market expenditures for the Indian service, authorized by the Interior Department, up to and including January 31, 1884, together with a communication from the Commissioner of Indian Affairs.

TEBRUARY 18, 1884.—Referred to the Committee on Expenditures in the Interior Department and ordered to be printed.

DEPARTMENT OF THE INTERIOR, Washington, February 15, 1884.

SIR: Section 3 of the act of March 1, 1883 (22 Stat., 450), "making rovision for the current and contingent expenses of the Indian De-Partment," provides—

That no purchase of supplies for which appropriations are herein made exceeding in the aggregate five hundred dollars in value at any one time shall be made without first giving at least three weeks' notice by advertisement, except in cases of exigency, when, in the discretion of the Secretary of the Interior, who shall make official record constituting the contingency, and shall report the same to Congress at its next session, he may direct that purchases may be made in open market in amount not exceeding three thousand dollars.

In accordance with the foregoing provision of the act noted, I have the honor to transmit herewith a statement of open-market expenditures for the Indian service authorized by this Department during the current fiscal year up to and including January 31, 1884, together with copy of letter of 9th instant from the Commissioner of Indian Affairs, masmitting said statement to this Department.
