Resolved, That the Secretary of the Interior be, and he is hereby, directed to furnish for the information of the Senate copies of all papers and correspondence filed in his office since the 4th day of March, 1885, relating to the appropriation of \$300,000 for the Cherokee Nation of Indians, and the alleged misappropriation of a portion thereof.
