REPORT:

[To accompany bill S. 632.]

The Committee on Indian Affairs, to whom was referred the bill (S. 632) to provide for the settlement of the estates of deceased Kickapoo Indians in the State of Kansas, and for other purposes, having considered the same, and having found it the same, word for word, as House bill 710, previously considered and favorably reported by this committee, do report the same back to the House with the recommendation that it do pass, and that the said bill (H. R. 710) do lie on the table.
