RESOLUTION:

Resolved, That Wednesday, January 5, 1887, be set apart for the consideration of House bill 6973, reported from the select committee on exenditures for Indians and Yellowstone Park, to be considered in the Louse as in Committee of the Whole House, not to interfere with general appropriation bills, bills raising revenue, nor prior orders; and if for any reason said bill should not be considered, or the consideration thereof completed on that day, that this order shall continue from day to day until said bill is finally disposed of by the House.
