REPORT:

[To accompany bill H. R. 10394.]

The Committee on Appropriations, in reporting back to the Senate the bill "making appropriations for the current and contingent expenses of the Indian Department, and for fulfilling treaty stipulations with the various Indian tribes for the year ending June 30, 1888, and for other purposes," present the following statement, showing somewhat in detail the estimates for these purposes for the fiscal year 1888, the amounts provided by the House bill, and the amounts recommended by the Senate Committee on Appropriations, and the amounts appropriated for the current fiscal year:
