CONCURRENT RESOLUTION:

Resolved by the Senate of the United States (the House of Representatives concurring), That the President of the United States be requested to return to the Senate Senate bill 2929, "to authorize the Paris, Choctaw and Little Rock Railway Company to construct and operate a railway, telegraph, and telephone line through the Indian Territory, and for other purposes."
