REPORT:

[To accompany bill H. R. 2835.]

The Select Committee on Indian Depredation Claims, to whom was referred the bill (H. R. 2835) for the relief of John P. Walker, submit the following report:

We find that claimant owned property in southern Oregon during the Rogue River Indian war of 1855-'56, and that during said hostilities said Indians took and destroyed the same, which was of the value of \$500.

We therefore recommend the payment of said sum.
