REPORT:

[To accompany bill H. R. 2830.]

The Select Committee on Indian Depredation Claims, to whom was referred the bill (H. R. 2830) for the relief of B. B. Bishop, submit the following report:

We find that said claimant lost the property described by Indian depredations in the Indian war of 1855-'56 in Oregon and Washington Territories by various bands of Indians, and that said property was of the value of \$1,558; that said B. B. Bishop is a man of credibility, and his statements can be relied on, and we therefore recommend the payment of the said sum of \$1,558.
