Mr. HERMANN, from the Select Committee on Indian Depredation Claims, submitted the following

REPORT:

[To accompany bill H. R. 2816.]

The Select Committee on Indian Depredation Claims, to whom was referred the bill (H. R. 2816) for the relief of Mrs. Kate Hatton, submit the following report:

Your committee find that claimant is a resident of Klamath County, Oregon, and in November, 1872, owned property therein which is shown to be of the value of \$4,297, and which was destroyed and carried off by the Modoc tribe of Indians on said date; that she never recovered any portion thereof, nor any compensation therefor; that the Indians were in hostilities at the time.

We recommend the payment of said sum of \$4,297.
