Mr. WILSON, of Missouri, from the Committee on Pensions, submitted  
the following

**REPORT:**

[To accompany H. R. 3202.]

The Committee on Pensions, to whom was referred the bill (H. R. 3202) granting a pension to Nancy E. Renfro, have considered the same and report as follows:

The claimant's late husband, William P. Renfro, deceased, was a private in Capt. John W. Otey's company of Alabama Volunteers, and served from May 26, 1838, to July 16, 1838, in the Creek Indian war. Carroll Renfro and John W. Moon, citizens of Ouachita County, Ark., testify to the identity of the claimant as the widow of the soldier, and that she is about 70 years of age, with no property or income, and entirely dependent upon her own efforts for a livelihood.

There are many precedents for the allowance of the relief prayed for, and your committee, believing the bill to be a meritorious one, respectfully return the same, recommending its passage.
