Mr. ALLEN, from the Committee on Indian Affairs, submitted the following

REPORT:

[To accompany H. R. 299.]

The Committee on Indian Affairs to whom was referred House bill 299, having had the same under consideration, report the same back with amendments, as follows:

Section 1, line 11, strike out "three" and insert "two," and in line 13, same section, strike out "ninety-seven" and insert "ninety-six." Strike out all of sections 2, 3, and 4, and amend the title by striking out the words "and to confer additional powers upon said company." Your committee recommend the passage of the bill as amended.

The bill simply gives an extension of time to a railroad company which has completed a considerable portion of its line, but on account of the financial stringency has not been able to fully complete it in the time allowed.
