Mr. WILSON, from the Committee on Indian Affairs, submitted the following

REPORT:

[To accompany amendment to H. R. 6249.]

The Committee on Indian Affairs have had under consideration amendment H. R. 6249, intended to be proposed by Mr. Teller to the bill (H. R. 6249) making appropriations for current and contingent expenses of the Indian Department, and report the same favorably with the following amendments:

After line 30, on page 2, add:

To Stephen W. Parker, three thousand dollars; to David A. McKnight, two thousand dollars; to C. M. Carter, three hundred and thirty-three dollars; to Belva A. Lockwood, one thousand dollars.

And, as so amended, your committee favorably recommend the same, and ask that said amendment be sent to the Committee on Appropriations.
