REPORT:

[To accompany H. R. 10145.]

The Committee on Indian Affairs, having had under consideration the bill (H. R. 8269) granting to the Chicago, Rock Island and Pacific Railway Company the use of certain lands at Chickasha Station, and for a "Y" in the Chickasaw Nation, Ind. T., recommend the accompanying bill as a substitute therefor.

Your committee believe that the said substitute fully guards the interests of the Indians, and recommend that the substitute do pass.
