Mr. MITCHELL, of Oregon, submitted the following

RESOLUTION:

Resolved, That the Secretary of the Interior be, and he is hereby, directed to furnish to the Senate, as soon as possible, a copy of the report of the Commissioner of the General Land Office, dated April 8, 1878, to the Secretary of the Interior; a copy of the testimony accompanying report of Agent Joseph Emery, dated June 6, 1887, to the Commissioner of Indian Affairs, and copies of any other reports, papers, or correspondence in the records or files of the Department of the Interior, or the bureaus thereof, concerning the accuracy of the survey of the boundary lines of the Klamath Indian Reservation, in the State of Oregon, not furnished with the response made to the resolution of the Senate of May 21, 1894, contained in Senate Executive Document No. 129, Fifty-third Congress, second session; also, a careful estimate of the quantity of land lying between the boundaries of the said reservation, as surveyed under the direction of the Commissioner of the General Land Office, and the treaty boundaries thereof, as claimed by the Indians, and marked upon the tracing or diagram furnished by the Commissioner of Indian Affairs, and now on file in the General Land Office, a copy of which is contained in said Senate executive document.
