RESOLUTION:

Resolved, That the Secretary of the Treasury be, and he is hereby, requested to inform this House of the amount of the unexpended balance of the appropriation made by Congress August 5, 1854, and acts amendatory thereof and supplemental thereto, for the payment of expenses incurred by the State of California on account of Indian hostilities therein, and of California Indian-war bonds issued in payment therefor and carried into the surplus fund, and to report to this House if in his opinion there exists any valid reason why said unexpended balance should not now be reappropriated for the purposes named in said acts of Congress.
