Mr. DOCKERY, from the Committee on Appropriations, submitted the following

REPORT:

[To accompany H. R. 7097.]

In presenting the bill making appropriations for the legislative, executive, and judicial expenses of the Government for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1895, the Committee on Appropriations submit the following in explanation thereof:

The estimates on which the bill is based will be found on pages 9 to 69 and 77 to 84 of the Book of Estimates for 1895 and aggregate \$22,310,510.33.

The whole amount recommended in the accompanying bill is \$21,086,923.29, being a reduction under the estimates of \$1,223,587.04, and a reduction under the appropriation act for the current year of \$781,099.52.

The whole number of salaries specifically provided for in the bill is 10,110, being 363 less than the number estimated for and 558 less than the number provided for in the law for the current year.

In compliance with the order of the House made May 3, 1894, there is incorporated in the bill, as sections 3 to 25 inclusive thereof, the provisions of the bill H. R. 6948, "Improving the methods of accounting in the Treasury Department and for other purposes" as the same passed the House May 2, 1894, and appropriations are recommended in accordance therewith.

The appropriations recommended for 1895 under the provisions of said bill and in accordance with estimates of the Secretary of the Treas-

ury, as compared with the appropriations for the current year, are as follows:

In addition to the organization of the offices as indicated above for 1895 there is also recommended in the bill the following:

For the temporary employment of clerks within the classified service to complete the accounts in the offices of First and Second Comptrollers and Commissioner of Customs, on hand July first, eighteen hundred and ninety-four, twenty thousand dollars, or so much thereof as may be necessary.

To bring up the work transferred from office of Second Auditor to Indian division of office of Auditor for Interior Department, namely: Six clerks of class three; and six clerks of class two; in all, eighteen thousand dollars.

For additional force for bringing up work of assorting and checking money orders, two years in arrears, and for increased business, namely: For five clerks of class four; five clerks of class three; five clerks of class two; five clerks of class one; five clerks, at one thousand dollars each; and five clerks, at nine hundred dollars each; in all, thirty-nine thousand five hundred dollars.

#### LIMITATIONS.

Limitations with reference to appropriations made in the bill, not heretofore imposed, are recommended as follows:

On page 20, the following:

The clerical force now detailed to the Civil Service Commission from the several Executive Departments shall hereafter be under the direction and control of the said Commission as fully as if they were appropriated for thereunder, and the appropriations for their compensation made in this Act shall be transferred to and disbursed under the Commission; and for the fiscal year eighteen hundred and ninety-

six estimates for the salaries of said clerical force shall be submitted under the Civil Service Commission and omitted from the estimates of the several Departments on whose rolls they are now carried.

On page 26, the following:

That the Secretary of the Treasury shall detail a captain or first lieutenant of the Revenue-Cutter Service who shall be chief of the division of Revenue-Cutter Service, and a chief engineer who shall be engineer in chief of said service, but no additional pay or emoluments shall be allowed on account of such detail.

On page 30, the following:

The law clerks provided for in the offices of the Comptroller of the Treasury and of the several Auditors of the Treasury shall be skilled in the law, and shall be appointed in the same manner as chiefs of divisions are now appointed by the Secretary of the Treasury.

On page 66, the following:

That the Chief Signal Officer of the Army shall be provided with office room in the State, War, and Navy building, and that the medical dispensary shall be removed to the Medical Museum building.

On page 70, the following:

For printing and binding under the direction of the Secretary of the Navy of ten thousand copies of the Official Records of the War of the Rebellion, both of the Union and of the Confederate navies, so far as the same may be ready for publication during the fiscal year, fifteen thousand dollars; and of said number six thousand eight hundred and forty copies shall be for the use of the House of Representatives, two thousand one hundred and twelve copies for the use of the Senate, and one thousand and forty-eight copies for the use of the Navy Department and for distribution by the Secretary of the Navy among officers of the Navy and contributors to the work. The quotas herein authorized of said publication for the Senate and House of Representatives shall be sent by the Secretary of the Navy to such libraries, organizations, and individuals as may be designated by the Senators, Representatives, and Delegates of the Fifty-third Congress, it being the purpose of this distribution herein provided for to place these records in public libraries and with permanent organizations having libraries, so far as such libraries may exist in the several States and Territories. Each Senator shall designate not exceeding twenty-four and each Representative and Delegate not exceeding nineteen of such addresses, and the volumes shall be sent thereto from time to time as they are published, until the publication is completed, and all sets that may not be ordered to be distributed as provided herein shall be sold by the Secretary of the Navy for cost of publication, with ten per centum added thereto, and the proceeds of such sale shall be covered in the Treasury. If two or more sets of said volumes are ordered to the same address the Secretary of the Navy shall inform the Senators, Representatives, or Delegates who have designated the same, who thereupon may designate other libraries, organizations, or individuals. The Secretary of the Navy shall inform distributees at whose instance the volumes are sent.

On page 85, in connection with the appropriation per diem of special examiners of the Pension Office, the following:

That whenever it shall be necessary for the chief or assistant chief to travel on official business outside of the District of Columbia, by direction of the Commissioner, they shall receive the same allowance in lieu of subsistence and for transportation as is herein provided for special examiners and detailed clerks engaged in field service.

On page 87, in connection with the appropriation for photolithographing for the Patent Office, the following:

Said photolithographing or otherwise producing plates and copies referred to in this and the preceding paragraph to be done under the supervision of the Commissioner of Patents, and in the city of Washington, or within such a reasonable distance therefrom as the Secretary of the Interior and the Commissioner of Patents may consider to be not disadvantageous to the Department.

On page 91, the following:

The Secretary of the Interior may hereafter authorize one of the geologists to sign such letters, papers, and documents, and to perform such other duties in connection with the Geological Survey as he may direct, and to act as Director of the Geological Survey in the absence of that officer, or in case of a vacancy in said office.

On page 106, in connection with the appropriation for the force for the care and protection of the court-house in Washington, the following:

That hereafter one-half of the salaries of this force and of the salary of the warden of the jail of the District of Columbia shall be paid out of the revenues of the District of Columbia, and estimates for such expenses shall each year hereafter be submitted in the annual estimates for the expenses of the government of the District of Columbia.

On page 108, the following:

That the compensation of the clerks of the circuit courts of appeals shall be limited to the annual salary of three thousand dollars now provided by law, and that said clerks shall make to the Secretary of the Treasury a return of all costs and fees of whatever kind collected by them as such clerks, and after deducting the incidental expenses of their respective offices, including clerk hire, said expenses to be certified by the senior circuit judge of the proper circuit, shall pay any surplus of such costs and fees that may remain into the Treasury of the United States at the time of making said return: *Provided further*, That the surplus of such costs and fees which may accrue on account of the fiscal year eighteen hundred and ninety-five shall not be paid into the Treasury, but shall be expended under the direction of the Attorney-General for law books for the use of the circuit courts of appeals.
