The Committee on Indian Affairs having had under consideration the bill (S. 1266) to extend and amend an act entitled "An act to authorize the Kansas and Arkansas Valley Railway to construct and operate additional lines of railway through the Indian Territory, and for other purposes," approved February 24, A. D. 1891, and finding the same to be identical in form with House bill 5123, heretofore reported favorably from the committee, report the same to the House and recommend that it be passed in lieu of House bill 5123, and that the latter lie on the table.
