No. 249, of the second session of the present Congress, and have been provisionally appropriated for by the act of Congress approved August 23, 1894. The three judgments reported as having been rendered on December 24, 1894, were included in the response to Senate resolution of December 22, 1894, embodied in Senate Ex. Doc. No. 32, of the present session, but have not been appropriated for.
