Mr. BLANCHARD, from the Committee on Indian Affairs, submitted the following

REPORT:

[To accompany S. 2365.]

The Committee on Indian Affairs, to whom was referred the bill (S. 2365) entitled "A bill for the relief of Northrup & Chick," having had the same under consideration, report it back favorably, with the following amendment: After the word "Chick," in line 12, add "without interest."

Your committee recommend as thus amended the bill be passed.

In support of this recommendation they refer to the letters of the Secretary of the Interior and Commissioner of Indian Affairs printed in the report accompanying the bill (S. 2364) for the relief of Silas P. Keller.
