The Committee on Appropriations, to whom was referred the bill (H. R. 8518) making appropriations for sundry civil expenses of the Government for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1896, and for other purposes, report the same to the Senate with various amendments, and present herewith statements showing the amounts estimated for these purposes in the Book of Estimates, the amounts provided by the bill as passed by the House of Representatives, the amounts recommended by the committee with the items in detail of increase and reduction of House bill, and the amounts of the sundry civil appropriation act for the fiscal year 1895.
