Mr. TERRY, from the Committee on the Judiciary, submitted the following

REPORT:

[To accompany H. R. 7690.]

The Committee on the Judiciary, having had under consideration H. R. 7690, report the same back to the House with the recommendation that it be passed with the following amendments:

On page 2, section 4, in line 24, after the word "order" insert the following words: "but the court may for good cause shown postpone the trial."

On page 2, section 4, in line 32, strike out the word "as."
