Mr. CURTIS, of Kansas, from the Committee on Indian Affairs, submitted the following

REPORT:

[To accompany H. R. 5651.]

The Committee on Indian Affairs, having had under consideration the bill (H. R. 5651) authorizing the Missouri, Oklahoma and Texas Railway Company to construct and operate a railway through the Indian Territory, recommend the passage of the bill with the following amendments suggested by the Commissioner of Indian Affairs, to wit:

In line 9, section 2, strike out the word "three" before "hundred" and insert the word "two."

In line 3, section 5, insert the words "or individuals" after the word "tribes" and before the word "through."
