**LETTER FROM THE SECRETARY OF THE INTERIOR, IN RESPONSE TO RESOLUTION OF THE SENATE OF MARCH 11, 1896, TRANSMITTING A LETTER FROM THE COMMISSIONER OF INDIAN AFFAIRS, SHOWING THE PRESENT STATE AND CONDITION OF THE FUNDS OR ANNUITIES OF THE CHEROKEE, CHOCTAW, CHICKASAW, CREEK, AND SEMINOLE TRIBES OF INDIANS.**

SIR: In conformity with the "resolution" of the Senate, dated the 11th instant, I have the honor to herewith transmit a copy of a letter, dated the 16th instant, from the Commissioner of Indian Affairs, showing the "present state and condition of the funds or annuities of the Cherokee, Choctaw, Chickasaw, Creek, and Seminole tribes of Indians under the control of the United States, and for the future payment of which the United States is obligated by law or treaty.

SIR: I have the honor to acknowledge the receipt, by your reference of the 12th instant for report, of the following Senate resolution, namely:

*Resolved*, That the Secretary of the Interior is directed to inform the Senate of the present state and condition of the funds or annuities of the Cherokee, Choctaw, Chickasaw, Creek, and Seminole tribes of Indians under the control of the United States, and for the future payment of which the United States is obligated by law or treaty.

The following statement will exhibit the present state and condition of the funds and the annuities of the tribes named:
