The Committee on Indian Affairs, to whom was referred the bill (S. 3838) for the relief of Edward Kolb, of Washington, D. C., report the same back with a recommendation that it pass amended as follows: In line 5 strike out the words "six hundred" and insert in their stead

In line 5 strike out the words "six hundred" and insert in their stead the words "two hundred and eighty-six," so that the bill will conform to the recommendation of the Interior Department.
