REPORT.

[To accompany H. R. 6358.]

The Committee on Indian Affairs, to whom was referred the bill (H. R. 6358) to authorize the Nebraska, Kansas and Gulf Railway Company to construct and operate a line of railway through Oklahoma and the Indian Territory, and for other purposes, return the same to the House with the recommendation that it do pass without amendment.

Your committee find that this is a bona fide corporation, organized in good faith for the purposes of constructing the proposed road.
