REPORT.

[To accompany H. R. 9477.]

The Committee on Indian Affairs, to whom was referred House bill 9477, having had the same under consideration, return the same to the House with the recommendation that it do pass.

The charter of this company will expire in March, 1899, and, the company having expended a considerable sum of money in surveying its route and in the preliminary work looking to the construction of this road, your committee believe that the time for the completion of this road granted by the bill should be allowed.
