#### Committee of Claims, to whom was referred the petition of Samuel. Miller, with the bill for his relief, report:

the prease from the statement of the petitioner that, in Decem-M5, an Indian of the Cherokee tribe, who had been charged with and committed to the jail in Huntsville, Alabama, made his from said jail; that shortly thereafter, the petitioner, with conble trouble and at the risk of his life, arrested said Indian, named d, otherwise called Rabbit, and placed him again in the custody heeper of the said jail.

statement of the petitioner is corroborated by the attestations of trict attorney of the United States for the northern district of Alaand the jailor to whom the said Indian was delivered; who also that a reward of one hundred dollars was offered and published in wspapers at Huntsville, under the authority of the said district atand which, it appears, has not been received by the petitioner.

The committee being satisfied of the merits of the case, and with the sourced, report the bill to the Senate without amendment.
