¹ Claims allowed by the Commissioner of Internal Revenue under the decision of the Supreme Court, in the case of Railroad v. Jackson (7 Wallace, 232), for the amount withheld by railroad companies and paid to the United States as internal-revenue tax on the interest and dividends that accrued from September 1, 1862, to March 1, 1866, on the railroad bonds and stock that were owned by the nonresident aliens named herein as claimants, and to whom the respective sums are due and payable. The Comptroller feels bound by the decision of the Supreme Court in the case of the United States v. Sebastian Kaufman (96 U. S. Reports, 567), to certify the claims herein reported for the refunding of taxes illegally collected, which have been allowed by the Commissioner of Internal Revenue and recommends that the appropriation, if made for these claims, may be made in the name of the claimants set forth in this schedule.
