DEPARTMENT OF THE INTERIOR, *February 12, 1861.*

SIR: To meet expenses contemplated by the act approved the 8th instant, providing "for a superintendent of Indian affairs for Washington Territory and additional agents," I have the honor to request that the following appropriations may be made.

For compensation of superintendent of Indian affairs and three additional agents in Washington Territory for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1861, \$2,527 77.

For compensation of superintendent of Indian affairs and three additional agents in Washington Territory for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1862, \$7,000.
