HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION No. 28.

*Resolved by the house of representatives, (the senate concurring therein,) That our senators and representative in Congress be, and they are hereby, instructed to use their influence with the government to secure to the State of Kansas for the support of schools, the 16th and 36th sections of the Cherokee Indian lands within said State of Kansas.*

*Resolved, That the secretary of state is hereby directed to furnish a copy of these resolutions to each of our senators and our representatives in Congress.*
