R E P O R T .

The Committee on Indian Affairs, to whom was referred the letter of the Secretary of the Interior, communicating a letter of the Commissioner of Indian Affairs, and a report with abstract by John G. Pratt, United States Indian agent, (hereto appended and made a part of this report,) of claims for stock stolen from the Delaware Indians since 1854, and recommending an appropriation for the payment of the claims as stipulated in the fourteenth article of the treaty with said Indians of 4th July, 1866, are of opinion that the claims as awarded by said agent are just and ought to be paid, amounting to \$26,284.
