SIR: On the 13th ultimo I had the honor to receive a resolution of the Senate, of that date, in the following words, viz:

*Resolved, That the Secretary of the Interior inform the Senate, if not deemed incompatible with the public interest, whether the duty imposed upon each Indian agent by the tenth section of the act making appropriations for the current and contingent expenses of the Indian Department for the year ending June thirty, eighteen hundred and seventy-six, and for other purposes, approved March three, eighteen hundred and seventy-five, requiring each "Indian agent to keep a book of itemized expenditures of every kind, with a record of all contracts, together with the receipts of money from all sources," has been complied with by the said agents.*

In reply to said resolution I have the honor to transmit herewith a copy of report, dated the 13th instant, from the Commissioner of Indian Affairs, together with the statement therein noted.
